



MEROOGAL WOMEN'S ART PRIZE 2014

Women artists from across NSW have created works in response to Nowra's historic Meroogal house museum for this year's Meroogal Women's Art Prize.

This non-acquisitive art prize was established to celebrate the creativity of female artists of NSW. The Meroogal Women's Art Prize invites female artists to respond to the house museum's history, stories and fascinating collection and to create artworks that reflect Meroogal, a house that was handed down through four generations of women from one local family.

This year's exhibition features 39 works by 34 artists from across the state. Artworks range from photography, installation, print, ceramics, painting and sound and provide a new lens through which to view Meroogal's story and history.
